

# CHRIST'S DIVINITY- SCRIPTURAL TESTIMONY

But he held his peace and answered nothing. Again, the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed Mark 14.61

#### 1. His Own Words Bear Witness

- A. Mark 14.62, And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven
- B. Matthew 26.63, "Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless, I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- C. John 10.30, "I and my Father are one."
- D. John 12.45, "And he that seeth me seeth him that sent me."

#### 2. The Father Bears Witness

- A. Matthew 3.17 "And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."
- B. Matthew 17.5 "While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him."
- C. John 8.18 "I am one that bear witness of myself, and the Father that sent me beareth witness of me."
- D. 1 John 5.9 "If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son."

## 3. The Apostles Bear Witness

- A. Matthew 16.16 "And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
- B. John 1.1 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- C. Romans 1.4 "And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:"
- D. Col 2.9 "For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily."

### 4. The Scriptures Bear Witness

- A. John The Baptist, John 1.34 "And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of God."
- B. The Works of Christ, John 5.36 "But I have greater witness than *that* of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me."
- C. The Father, John 5.37 "And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape."
- D. The Old Testament, John 5.39 "Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me."
- E. Christ Himself, John 8.14 "Jesus answered and said unto them, Though I bear record of myself, *yet* my record is true: for I know whence I came, and whither I go; but ye cannot tell whence I come, and whither I go."
- F. The holy Spirit, John 15.26 "But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, *even* the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:
