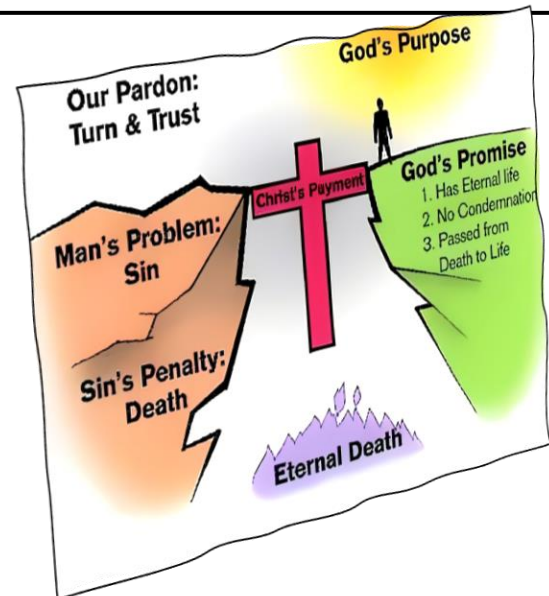


Present Possessions of the Believer
